INSTRUCTIONS TO TENDERERS

1.0 GENERAL TERMS

- (a) Tender will be available on NIC e-procurement portal URL "<http://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app>" from 17-05-2018, 09.00AM to 09-06-2018, 06.00PM.
- (b) EMD amount of Rs. 1,00,000/- & Tender fee of Rs. 1,000/- (non-refundable) should be paid online through NEFT or RTGS in NIEPMD account and payment receipt to be uploaded with tender document. Bids without Tender Fee and EMD amount shall not be considered for further evaluation **Tender received without Tender Fee or lesser amounts will be summarily rejected.** No further correspondence will be accepted on the subject. Bidder applied in response of previous tender notice can upload the EDM payment receipt of previous payment. They need not to pay the EMD again. However tender fees to be paid by each bidder and no previous payment receipts will be made valid in any circumstances.
- (c) Units registered with National Small Industries Corporation (NSIC), Small Scale Industrial (SSI), are exempted from payment of EMD for the item tendered and subject to registration certificate being valid as on date of quotation. Technical Bid is accompanied by a photocopy of valid NSIC/SSI Registration Certificate / Review Certificate.
- (d) Photocopy of application for registration as NSIC/SSI or for renewal of NSIC/SSI will not be acceptable. Such offers will be treated as offers received without EMD. No further correspondence will be accepted on the subject.
- (e) Registration with DGS&D will also entitle the Tenderer to claim exemption from payment of EMD.
- (f) **However no firm is exempted for paying tender fees, irrespective of any category bidders have to pay the nonrefundable tender fees Rs. 1000/- for consideration of their bids.**
- (g) No alteration or amendments shall be allowed after submission and opening of the tenders.
- (h) In case of any dispute arising with regards to this tender or its conclusion, the decision of the Director NIEPMD shall be final.
- (i) Tenderers are advised to acquaint themselves fully with the description of work, scope of services, time schedule and terms and conditions including all the provisions of the Tender Document before framing up their tender.

2.0 SITE PARTICULARS

Tenderers are advised to inspect and examine the site and its surroundings and satisfy themselves before submitting their tenders as to site conditions, means of access to the site.

3.0 SUBMISSION OF TENDER

The expression "Tender Notice" referred to in the Tender Documents shall be deemed to include any Notice / Letter Inviting Tender with respect to the work forming the subject matter of the documents and vice-versa.

The tender complete in all respects shall be submitted along with Earnest Money and Tender Fees as stipulated in the Notice / Letter Inviting Tender only. Tenders without Earnest Money Deposit and Tender Fees will be out rightly rejected.

3.1 UPLOADING OF BIDS

Interested bidder may submit their quotes by giving all the necessary documents in English or Hindi as specified. **The tender must be submitted online through Central Public Procurement Portal e-procurement application only through URL: <http://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app> only.** No manual bids will be entertained under any circumstances.

The Tender document attached must be direct, concise, and complete and arranged in an organized and structured manner.

To participate in online bidding process, Bidders must procure a Digital Signature Certificate as per Information Technology Act-2000 using which they can digitally sign and encrypt their electronic bids. Bidders can procure the same from any CCA approved certifying agency, i.e. TCS, Safecrypt, Ncode, eMudhra etc. Bidders who already have a valid Digital Signature Certificate (DSC) need not procure a new DSC.

NIEPMD will not be responsible for delay in online submission due to any reason. For this, bidders are requested to upload the complete bid proposal well advance in time so as to avoid issues like slow speed, choking of web site due to heavy load or any other unforeseen problems.

4.0 ABNORMAL RATES

If it is noticed that the unit rates quoted by the Tenderer for any items are unusually high or unusually low, it will be sufficient cause for rejection of the tender unless the Institute is convinced about the reasonableness of the unit rates on scrutiny of the analysis for such unit rate to be furnished by the tenderer on demand.

5.0 DEVIATIONS TO TENDER CLAUSES:

Tenderers are advised to submit the tenders strictly based on the terms and conditions and specification contained in the Tender Documents and not to stipulate any deviations. Conditional tenders are liable to be rejected.

6.0 VALIDITY OF OFFER

Tender submitted by tenderers shall remain valid for acceptance for a minimum period of 90 days from the date of opening of the tenders.

7.0 AWARD OF WORK

Institute reserves the right to split the job into two or more parts and to award the work to separate agencies/Contractor / Supplier s quoting lowest rates.

8.0 ACCEPTANCE / REJECTION OF TENDER

i) Institute does not bind itself to accept the lowest tender.

ii) Institute also reserves the right to accept or reject any tender in part or full without assigning any reason whatsoever.

iii) Institute also reserves the absolute right to reject any or all the tenders at any time solely based on the past unsatisfactory performance by the bidder(s) the opinion/decision of NIEPMD regarding the same shall be final and conclusive.

9.0 FIRM RATES

The rates quoted by bidder shall remain firm till completion of all works even during the extended period, if any, on any account what so ever. It is provided that the Contractor / Supplier s shall not change any of the rates, quoted in the tender till the completion of work.

GENERAL CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT

1. Where the context so requires, words importing the singular only also include the plural and vice versa.
2. Institute shall mean “**National Institute for Empowerment of Persons with Multiple Disabilities (NIEPMD).**” (An Autonomous Body under DEPwD,

MSJ&E, Government of India) having its registered office at East Coast Road (ECR), Muttukadu, Kovalam (Post), Chennai – 603 112 (Tamilnadu).

3. The Contractor / Supplier is required to approach the Institute for execution of agreement for the said work as per the prescribed proforma to be provided by the Institute on a non-judicial stamp paper of Rs.100/- within 10 days from the issue of the letter of award.

4. Contract Documents:

The Contractor / Supplier shall be provided, free of charge, one certified true copy of the Contract Documents.

5. Works to be carried out:

The work to be carried out under the Contract shall, except as otherwise provided in these conditions, include all labour, materials, taxes tools, plant, equipment and transport which may be required in preparation of and for and in the full and entire execution and completion of the works.

6. Inspection of Site:

The Contractor / Supplier shall inspect and examine the Site and its surrounding and shall satisfy himself before submitting his tender as to the nature of the Site, the quantities and nature of works and material necessary for the completion of the Works and the means of access to the Site, he may require and in general shall himself obtain all necessary information as to risks, contingencies and other circumstances which may influence or affect this tender.

7. Sufficiency of Tender:

The Contractor / Supplier shall be deemed to have satisfied himself before tendering as to the Correctness and sufficiency of his tender for the works and of the rates and prices quoted in the Schedule of Quantities, which rates and prices shall except as otherwise provided, cover all his obligations under the contract and all matters and things necessary for the proper completion and maintenance of the Works.

8. Security Deposit:

- 8.1 Total security deposit shall be 10 % of the accepted tender cost and shall be deducted from the payment to be made to the Contractor / Supplier. Earnest Money deposited shall be adjusted in the security deposit. The security deposit can be accepted in the form of unconditional Bank Guarantee of nationalized bank/scheduled bank.

- 8.2 **Refund of Security deposit:** Security deposit shall be refunded to the Contractor / Supplier after successful completion of defect liability period of 36 months from the completion of work.

- 8.3 No interest shall be payable to the Contractor / Supplier on the Security Deposit furnished / recovered from the Contractor / Supplier, by the Institute.

9. Time and Extension for Delay:

- 9.1 The time allowed for execution of the works as specified in the Appendix or the extended time in accordance with these conditions shall be the essence of the Contract. The execution of the works shall commence from the 7th day after the date on which the Institute issues Work Order to commence the work.
- 9.2 If the work be delayed by
- (a) Force majeure or
 - (b) Serious loss or damage by fire, or
 - (c) Civil commotion, local combination of workmen strike or lockout, affecting any of the trades employed on the work, or
 - (d) Any other cause, which, in the absolute discretion of the authority mentioned in Appendix, is beyond the Contractor's/Supplier's control;
- 9.3 Then upon the happening of any such event causing delay, the Contractor/ Supplier shall immediately give notice thereof in writing to the Officer- in-Charge purchase section but shall nevertheless use constantly his best endeavors to prevent or make good the delay and shall do all that may be reasonably required to the satisfaction of the Officer- in-Charge to proceed with the Works.
10. The Contractor / Supplier shall arrange, at his own expense, all tools, plant and equipment hereafter referred to as (T & P) labour, P.O.L. & electricity required for completion of the work.

11. FORCE MAJEURE

Any delays in or failure of the performance of either party herein shall not constitute default hereunder or give rise to any claim for damages, if any, to the extent such delays or failure of performance is caused by occurrences such as Act of god or the public enemy; expropriation or confiscation of facilities by Government authorities, or in compliance with any order or request of any Governmental authorities or due acts of war, rebellion or sabotage or fires, floods, explosions, riots or illegal joint strikes of all the workers of all the Contractor / Supplier s.

12. MATERIALS

All materials to be provided by the Contractor / Supplier shall be in conformity with the specifications laid down in the contract and the Contractor shall, if requested by the Officer- in-Charge, furnish proof to the satisfaction of Officer-in-Charge in this regard.

13 Specifications

- 13.1 The details of commercial gym equipment specification/requirements and relevant information have been provided in **Annexure –II Scope of work.**
- 13.2 If particular commercial gym equipment including accessories is available as both indigenously and imported, then offers may be provided for both the equipment/accessories i.e. indigenous and imported, separately in Indian currency.
- 13.3 It must be noted that the commercial gym equipment to be supplied to NIEPMD shall have a **minimum guarantee/warranty of 03 years (36 Months) from the date of successful installation.**
- 13.4 **The firms are also requested to offer their rates for providing Annual Maintenance Contract (AMC) for the period of another 02 years after expiry of guarantee/warranty available at the time of installation (i.e. 36 months from date of installation). However, it shall be the sole prerogative of NIEPMD to decide as to whether or not AMC contract may be entered at the time of placing the supply order.**
- 13.5 **Option Clause:** - During the currency of the contract, the buyer (NIEPMD, Chennai) can exercise an option to procure an additional 50% of the original contracted quantity in accordance with the same terms & conditions of the present contract. This will be applicable within currency of contract. The Bidder is to confirm the acceptance of the same for inclusion in the contract. It will be entirely the discretion of the Buyer to exercise this option or not.
- 13.6 **Repeat Order Clause:** - The buyer (NIEPMD, Chennai) can order up to 50% quantity of the items under the present contract within six months from the date of supply/successful completion of the work, the cost, terms & conditions remaining the same. The bidder is to confirm acceptance of this clause. It would be entirely the discretion of the buyer to place the repeat order or not.
- 13.7 **Apportionment of Quantity:** If there is apprehension that the L 1 may not have the capacity to supply the entire requisite quantity within the defined time the order may be placed on L 2, L 3 and so on for the balance quantity at L 1 rates, provided this is acceptable to them. The ratio of splitting of supply order will be worked as per the capability of the L 1 firm

14. Warranty:-

- 14.1 Gym and Fitness Equipments should be under three years free on-site comprehensive warranty and support from the date of installation, including free provision of spare parts, kits as and when required.
- 14.2 If the Equipments remains down beyond 48 hours, the firm will be required to provide a stand-by of the same or higher configuration, failing which the Director, NIEPMD Chennai will arrange for the Equipments on rental basis at the rate decided by the Director, NIEPMD, Chennai, which shall be final and binding, and the cost thereof shall be adjusted against the Security Deposit/Bank Guarantee.

- 14.3 Warranty period begins from the date of satisfactory installation and commissioning at location certified by Officers of NIEPMD.
- 14.4 If the Gym or Fitness Equipments is down beyond 48 hours, penalty at the rate of Rs. 500/- (Rupees Five hundred only) per day per fault will be charged.
- 14.5 Supplier shall visit the site at least once in every Three months to carryout preventive maintenance and fine-tune of the Equipments besides regular service calls during the warranty period.
- 14.6 On completion of the Warranty period, the unconditional Bank Guarantee without any interest accrued shall be released after satisfying that proper free warranty support has been provided during warranty period of three year for all the items. If considered necessary, suitable amount of penalty shall be recovered from the vendor out of their due payments or from their Security Deposit or by raising claims, while releasing the Security Deposit.
- 14.7 **The supplier has to provide training on operation of Gym and Fitness Equipments to the officials of NIEPMD. In addition to above, vendor would also provide onsite training to end-user at the time of installation of equipment.**
- 14.8 Any disputes arising out of this tender will be under the Jurisdiction of Court of Chennai only.

15. Labour:

a.) The Contractor / Supplier shall employ its labour/ workmen in sufficient numbers to complete the work in the stipulated time. The Contractor / Supplier shall not employ in connection with the Works any person who has not completed eighteen years of age.

b.) All the workers or employees deployed by the Contractor / Suppliers shall consider the employees of Contractor / Supplier and Institute shall not have any liability what so ever in nature in regard to such workers/employees.

c.) The Contractor / Supplier shall comply with all statutory norms of Central/ State Govt. with regard to labour/ workmen employed by him. Violation of any such norm shall be the sole responsibility of the Contractor / Supplier. The Contractor / Supplier shall indemnify and keep indemnified the Institute against all such claims arising out:

i) Of third party loss/ damage to life or property caused by/ during execution of the work.

ii) Of loss/ damage to the workmen engaged by the Contractor / Supplier during execution of the work

iii) Due to non-compliance of applicable PF/ Labour laws, ESI regulations etc.

16. Inspection and Approval:

The Director, NIEPMD or his representative shall have powers at any time to inspect and examine any part of the Works and the Contractor / Supplier shall give such facilities as may be required for such inspection and examination.

17. Liquidated Damages for Delay

Time is essence of the contract. In case the CONTRACTOR / SUPPLIER fails to complete the whole work within the stipulated period, he shall be liable to pay liquidated damages @ 2.5% of the value of contract per week and or part thereof of the delay subject to a maximum of 25% of the value of the contract. The amount of Compensation may be adjusted or set-off against any sum payable to the Contractor / Supplier under this or any other contract with the Institute.

18. Defect Liability Period

The Contractor / Supplier shall be responsible to make good and remedy any defect in the work executed within defect liability period of Three year which shall be reckoned from the date of completion of the works to the Institute.

19. Instruction and Notices:

19.1 Subject as otherwise provided in this contract, all notices to be given on behalf of the Institute and all other actions to be taken on its behalf may be given or taken by the Officer- in-Charge or any officer for the time being entrusted with the functions, duties and powers of the Officer-in-Charge.

19.2 All instructions, notices and communications, etc., under the contract shall be given in writing and if sent by registered post to the last known place of abode or business of the Contractor / Supplier shall be deemed to have been served on the date when in the ordinary course of post these would have been delivered to him.

19.3 Foreclosure of Contract in Full or in Part due to Abandonment or Reduction in Scope of Work.

If at any time after acceptance of the tender the Institute shall decide to abandon or reduce the scope of the works for any reason whatsoever and hence not require the whole or any part of the Works to be carried out the Engineer- in- Charge shall give notice in writing to that effect to the Contractor / Supplier and Contractor / Supplier shall have no claim to any payment of compensation or otherwise whatsoever, on account of any profit or advantage which he might have derived from the execution of the works in full but which he did not derive in consequence of the foreclosure of the whole or part of the works.

19.4 The Contractor / Supplier shall be paid at Contract rates full amount for works executed at Site as certified by the Officer- in-Charge.

20. Cancellation of Contract in Full or in Part:

If the Contractor / Supplier /Supplier:

- a. At any time makes defaults in proceeding with the Works with due negligence and continues to do so even after a notice in writing of 7 days from the Purchase Department;
or
- b. Commits default in complying with any of the terms and conditions of Contract and does not remedy it or take effective steps to remedy it within 7 days after a notice in writing is given to him in that behalf by the Purchase Department; or
- c. Fails to complete the works or items of work on or before the date(s) of completion, and does not complete them within the period specified in a notice given in writing in that behalf by the Purchase Department; or
- d. Violates any of the terms and conditions stipulated in this agreement
- e. Being a company, passes a resolution or the Court makes an order for liquidation of its affairs, or a receiver or manager on behalf of the debenture holders is appointed or circumstances shall arise which entitle the Court or debenture holders to appoint a receiver or manager; or

21. Liability for Damage, Defects or Imperfections and Rectification thereof:

If the Contractor / Supplier or his workmen or employees shall injure or destroy any part of the building in which they may be working or any building, road, fence, etc. contiguous to the premises on which the work or any part of it is being executed, or if any damage shall happen to the work while in progress the Contractor / Supplier shall upon receipt of a notice in writing in that behalf make the same good at his own expense. If it shall appear to the Director, NIEPMD or his Representative at any time prior to the expiration of Defects Liability Period, that any work has been executed with unsound, imperfect or unskilled workmanship or that any material, article or equipment provided by the Contractor / Supplier are of sub -standard quality, shall, upon receipt of a notice in writing in that behalf from the Officer- in-charge, forthwith rectify or remove and replace the same so specified in whole or in part, as the case may require or as the case may be, and / or remove the materials or articles at his own expense, notwithstanding that same may have been inadvertently passed, certified and paid for and in the event of his notice aforesaid, the Officer- in-charge may rectify or remove and replace the work and / or remove and replace with others the materials or articles or equipment complained of, as the case may be, by other means at the risk and expense of the Contractor / Supplier .

In case the Contractor / Supplier fails to comply with the requirements of this condition, the Director, NIEPMD shall have the right to get the work done by other means at the cost of the Contractor / Supplier. Before taking such action, however, the Director, NIEPMD shall give three days notice in writing to the Contractor / Supplier.

22. VALUATION AND PAYMENT:

- 22.1 After carrying out the entire work successfully by the Contractor / Supplier , the

Contractor / Supplier /supplier shall submit the bill to the Institute for the payment. The Director, NIEPMD shall accept as otherwise stated ascertain and determine the value of work done in accordance with the contract agreement therewith

22.2 No escalation will be paid even in extended period, if any.

22.3 All statutory deductions as applicable like TDS, sales tax/VAT shall be made from the due payment of the Contractor / Supplier.

23. Income Tax/WCT/VAT

23.1 Income tax including surcharge if any, at the prevailing rate shall be deducted from the Contractor / Supplier 's bills as per the provision of Income Tax Act.

23.2 The Contractor / Supplier shall ascertain from the concerned commercial tax department regarding the applicability of Works Contract Tax / VAT/TIN. Necessary deductions will be made from the Contractor / Supplier 's bill as applicable.

24. ARBITRATION AND LAWS

Arbitration:

Except where otherwise provided for in the contract all questions and disputes relating to the meaning of the specifications, designs, and instructions herein before mentioned and as to the quality of workmanship or materials used onto work or as to any other question, claim right matter or thing whatsoever in any way arising out of or relating to the contract, designs, specifications, estimates, instructions, orders and these conditions or otherwise concerning the works, or the execution or failure to execute the same whether arising during the progress of the work or after the completion or abandonment thereof shall be referred to the sole arbitration of the Director of the NIEPMD, and if the Director, NIEPMD is unable or unwilling to act, to the sole arbitration of some other person appointed by the Director, NIEPMD willing to act as such arbitrator. There will be no objection if the arbitrator so appointed is an employee of the NIEPMD and that he had to deal with the matters to which the contract relates and that in the course of his duties as such he had expressed views on all or any of the matters in dispute or difference. The arbitrator to whom the matter is originally referred being transferred or vacating his office or being unable to act for any reason as aforesaid at the time of such transfer, vacation of office or inability to act., Director, NIEPMD shall appoint another person to act, as arbitrator in accordance with the terms of the Contract. It is also a term of this contract that no person other than a person appointed by Director, NIEPMD, as aforesaid should act as arbitrator and if for any reason, that is not possible, the matter is not to be referred to arbitration at all.

Subject as aforesaid the provision of the Indian Arbitration and Reconciliation Act, 1996, or any statutory modification or re-enactment thereof and the rules made there under and for the time being in force shall apply to the arbitration proceeding under this clause.

It is a term of the contract that the party invoking arbitration shall specify the dispute or disputes to be referred to arbitration under this clause together with the amount or amounts claimed in respect of each such dispute.

The arbitrators may from time to time with consent of this parties enlarge the time, for making and publishing the award.

The work under the contract shall, if reasonably possible continue during the arbitration proceedings and so payment due to payable to the Contractor / Supplier shall be withheld on account of such proceedings.

The Arbitrator shall be deemed to have entered on the reference on the date he issued notice to both parties fixing the date of the first hearing. The Arbitrator shall give a separate award in respect of each dispute of difference referred to him.

The venue of arbitration shall be such place as may be fixed by the Arbitrator in sole discretion.

The award of the arbitrator shall be final, conclusive and binding on all parties to this contract.

The cost of arbitration shall be borne by the parties to the dispute, as may be decided by the arbitrator(s).

The Indian Laws shall govern this contract for the time being in force. The courts at Chennai only shall have the jurisdiction
