

#### No. of Beneficiaries



## Best Practices under services: Information related to disabilities provided online, since COVID-19 Pandemic





#### No. of Beneficiaries







#### Helplines to heal the mind

From September 2020 to March 2021, Kiran helpline number (1800-599-0019) has attended to 1724 calls from Tamil Nadu and Puducherry. National Institute for Empowerment of Persons with Multiple Disabilities, Chennai is one of the coordinators of this initiative.

The hotline available in 13 languages caters to people in distress, mental health emergency and psychological caused due to the pandemic. The calls are handled by psychiatric social workers who forward them to clinical psychologists depend-

ing on the nature of help "Fifty-six per cent of the

callers who called the helpline number are men and says Rajesh Ramachandran, Rehabilitation Offic er, NIEPMD, Our data also shows that a majority of the callers are in the age group of 15 to 40 years, he

The operators have been sensitised not to ask the caller for name or any other details. Anxiety and depression are some of the top concerns fielding by the mental health professionals.

NIEPMD provided general provisions to 50 families during COVID 19 pandemic situation.
